

Doraleh Multi-Purpose (Phase I)

Soon the arrival of modern facilities in Djibouti



On 8th July 2016, marks a turning point in the fate of Port Multipurpose Doraleh

This date coincided with the holding of a ceremony at the headquarters of ZPMC in Shanghai, China, marking the celebration of the shipment of equipment for DMP. The Director General of the Port of Djibouti in SA was present in the Chinese metropolis. Mr. Saad Omar Guelleh has described the historic event before his interlocutors ZPMC. The detail explains the relatively supported thanks the senior Djibouti has sent managers to ZPMC. After routing and fixing equipment the senior ZPMC will take part in the official ceremony of the inauguration of DMP Phase I is planned for early 2017.

The Director General of the Port of Djibouti SA, Mr. Saad Omar Guelleh, and visited mission work in shanghai China.

On 8th July 2016, the top manager of Djibouti visited ZPMC headquarters where he participated in the ceremony marking the celebration of the shipment of

equipment for multipurpose port of Doraleh DMP or its acronym.

The event was part of the extension of the signing of a purchase order, confirmed earlier in Shanghai by the general manager of PDSA and leaders of ZPMC. The conclusion of this MoU goes back to November 30, 2014. This is in fact a contract covering the delivery of modern equipment of last generation multipurpose port at Doraleh. These include a dozen gantry cranes, units of RMG, and shore cranes with mobile unit's machineries that will be carried by sea to Djibouti. Their arrival in the country is scheduled August 10, 2016.

This date marks a crucial turning point in the fate of DMP. The Director General of the ASDP M Saad Omar Guelleh has described as historic in front of his interlocutors ZPMC. This seemed to agree. Since their parent contributes to the development of the proposed new port at Doraleh.
